We could put the single-phase siren at Sayde Drive. The siren with 3-phase would be installed at the SER Building on 219 North of Brockway. They have 3-phase capabilities there.

With the amount of weather alerts in the last couple of years and with tornado touchdowns in the Snyder Township area in the last 4 years, we feel that we need to alert the residents when severe weather is approaching.
